Winemaker's note

The Barossa Valley has the perfect climate and ideal grape varieties to produce Rosé. This Grenache Rose shows a pale salmon colour with a brilliant clarity and transparency. The wine is well balanced with fresh tart berry flavours of raspberry and strawberry. The palate is soft and round with a luscious creaminess followed by crisp, refreshing acidity to give a clean, balanced finish.

Vintage

The 2017 vintage started after a long wet winter, resulting in wet soils and a cooler than average spring, leading to the vines growing slowly but healthily.

March saw the beginning of an Indian summer which was perfect for consistent ripening, colour development and good natural acidity.

Vineyards

Made entirely from top quality grapes grown in the Barossa Valley with fruit for the 2017 Grenache Rosé sourced entirely from the Boehm Brothers vineyard in the Light Pass sub-district.

Perfect served chilled as an aperitif, otherwise enjoy with fresh seafood or spicy Asian dishes.
